Disability Advisory Group Meetings

Following community consultation to develop a Disability Action Plan, local services will hold the first Disability Advisory Group meeting in October. Northern District Community Health, Cohuna District Hospital, Gannawarra Shire Council and Kerang District Health are working together on the groups. The advisory groups were planned to engage people with a disability or caring for someone with a disability. The groups will help inform planning and services across all agencies to ensure safety and responsiveness to people living with a disability.

"The experience of people either living with a disability or caring for someone with a disability is so important for all health and community services," NDCH CEO Mandy Hutchinson said. "That the four biggest health and community service agencies in the Gannawarra Shire partnered to make this happen shows how committed we all are to safe, quality services and supports for people living with disability."

The advisory groups are planned to take place every three month's for the first six months. Then, a review involving participants for ongoing meetings will take place to make sure everyone is heard and getting what they need from the meetings. Funding has been applied for across the Shire with the support of other agencies and community groups that would help support local disability groups, including the advisory groups.

"The advisory groups help us tap into community networks that have not yet been heard from but whose voices are extremely important across the broader health service area," Cohuna District Hospital CEO Ben Maw said. "They give the community local people and services to communicate and share information that impacts on the wellbeing of people with disabilities and their carers."
