# **Gannawarra Says NO to Family Violence**



In November we joined forces with a number of local agencies for the Gannawarra Goes Orange Campaign, a Gannawarra Local Agency Meeting initiative.

While it is often hidden, family violence is higher in our region than the state average per 100,000 people.

At the core of family violence is power imbalance between men and women.

As long as we accept inequities between males and females, family violence will continue to be a problem. Differences in pay, job opportunities, cultural expectations and family roles all contribute to the cycle of family violence.

We need to call out disrespect towards women and support changes in our culture which contribute to supporting women.

### To be eligible for the NDIS, you need to

- Have a permanent disability that makes every day things really hard:
- Be under 65 years of age; and
- Be an Australian citizen or hold a permanent visa or a Protected Special Category visa.

# **Drought Assistance**

The Victorian Government's household financial relief, that is part of the 2 October Drought Response Package; Household Financial Relief program, opened recently on the CWA of Victoria's website.

The CWA's Drought Relief program will provide payments of up to \$3,000 to eligible farming families, farm workers and contractors, to assist with meeting household expenses such as residential rates, food, school expenses, rent, household and urgent medical & dental treatment.

Consistent with the On-Farm Drought Resilience Grant program, eligibility is based on:

### **Goulburn Murray Irrigation District (GMID)**

- Campaspe Shire, Gannawarra Shire, Greater Shepparton City, Loddon Shire, Moira Shire and Swan Hill Rural City
- irrigation farmer or have transitioned from an irrigation production system after 1 July 2018, or employed by an irrigation farming business or servicing/contracting to an irrigation farming businesses.

### **PRIVACY**

This practice is committed to maintaining the confidentiality of your personal health information. Your medical record is a confidential document. It is the policy of this practice to maintain the security of personal health information at all times and to ensure that this information is only available to authorised members of staff.

### **PRESCRIPTIONS**

All patients must be seen for repeat prescriptions. No phone or over the counter prescriptions will be taken. You may need a blood pressure or blood sugar check, or pathology which is ordered by your doctor. This ensures better health care for you and your family.

Scripts for Schedule 8 Medications (and some schedule 4) will not be given at your first consultation and only prescribed when your Doctor establishes your treatment plan with you.

### **FEES**

All accounts are required to be paid on the day of visit. The standard fee is \$75. Fees vary according to time/or services provided. Your claim will be sent to Medicare electronically who will pay your rebate direct to your nominated bank account. **We are not a bulk billing clinic.** 

### AGE & DISABILITY PENSION CARD HOLDERS

Pension card holders will be charged an out of pocket fee of \$30 payable on the day for three visits each calendar year.

### **HEALTHCARE CARD HOLDERS**

Healthcare card holders will be asked for a \$30 Gap Payment each visit instead of the \$75 pay on the day fee.
